


Microna saxatilis (Reynies, 1843)
NEW FOR THE BALEARIC ISLANDS

Two small Hydrobiids were found amongst some mollusks collected by Prof. Dr. J. H. Stock at the island of Mallorca. Dr. H. D. Boeters kindly identified them as *Microna saxatilis* (Reynies, 1843). The specimens have been collected on the island of Mallorca in a well, marked «1860» which is situated at the westside of the C 719 road (= south of Andratx near Camp de Mar) on 28 december 1977. As the species was not mentioned by GASULL (1963, 1969, 1972) this is the first record for *M.saxatilis* on the Baleares. BOETERS (1970) mentioned 15 subspecies of *M.saxatilis*, which are distributed from northwest Spain to south France and from Austria to Yugoslavia.



The specimens are in the collection of the Zoological Museum Amsterdam.
