

## **Una selecció de revistes internacionals d'antropologia i d'etnologia (anys 1990-1991-1992). Índex d'autors i temàtic.**

### **Introducció**

Aquest assaig bibliogràfic ofereix a les pàgines que segueixen un recull d'articles de caire antropològic publicats durant els anys 1990, 1991 i —quan això ha estat possible— 1992 a bona part de les més importants revistes d'antropologia de fora de l'Estat espanyol.<sup>1</sup>

La màxima pretensió d'aquest article és la d'esdevenir un útil pràctic de treball per a tots aquells estudiosos i persones interessades en les temàtiques i punts de vista de l'antropologia sòcio-cultural. Malgrat la inevitable manca d'exhaustivitat que els condicionaments de temps i d'espai han agreujat, hem intentat oferir un recull, el més complet possible, dels articles en diferents llengües publicats en gairebé 30 revistes<sup>2</sup> procedents de més de 10 països d'Europa, Amèrica i Àsia.

L'assaig es presenta dividit en dues parts: una primera, que ofereix una ordenació alfabètica per autors, i una segona que situa temàticament els diferents articles publicats durant aquests anys.

S'inclouen algunes revistes que, sense ser publicacions periòdiques de caràcter antropològic o etnològic, han publicat articles referits a aquestes disciplines. De la mateixa manera, i malgrat no situar-se estrictament dintre dels paràmetres de l'antropologia sòcio-cultural, hem decidit d'incloure també de-

terminades obres de prehistòria, arqueologia, antropologia biològica o etnologia, que sovint han aparegut publicades a algunes de les revistes d'antropologia buidades (especialment a les nord-americanes), i que corres-

ponen a una particular visió d'orientació interdisciplinària dins determinades tradicions antropològiques que ens ha semblat interessant de reflectir.

Esperem que la tasca feta arribi a convertir-se en una eina útil per tal d'observar les darreres aportacions aportades internacionalment dintre del camp de la disciplina antropològica.
